


## Tutorial Angoissee Anguish Graphic Look


This tutorial has a problem: "probably not applicable to people, unless you do some post-process"

Open your image and duplicate it.

Select copy layer and go to Gmic – Artistic – **Angoissee Anguish**. Output mode to a new layer




Select Angoissee layer and go to G'MIC \_ Artistic – **Colored Pencils**. Output mode to a new layer, too.




Set the resultant layer to **Luminance Mode**. And New from Visible.

Select Visible Layer and go to GMIC \_ Artistic – **Graphic Novel**. Default values and output to a new layer.



Select Graphic Novel Layer and Apply GMIC \_ Artistic **Vector Painting**. Details 9.6



Set the **original copy layer** upper the whole layers. And apply as layer mode to **LCh color**.

New from visible.

This result can be a first Final Angoisie Anguish Graphic Look




### Optional step

New from visible

Go to GMIC \_ Testing \_ Samj \_ Artistic \_ **Texture Coloree**. Output mode to a new layer.

Set the layer to **Linear Burn** and **80% opacity**.
